5 Assessment of requests for funding

The following requests had been submitted to the respective Local Authority SDO for support and to DB for circulation prior to the meeting:

1 GCSE Badminton Crash courses at Westminster Lodge, St Albans. Everyone Active (Kirsty Jones):: (previously circulated) In brief: 'Teens, aiming to reach 8-12 individuals, and helping them to develop their skills and confidence – working with Tanya Angus. Equipment costs – Maude sport £180 Yonex school badminton set including rackets, shuttles, two nets and a carry bag. Coach costs - £180 across 6 weeks. Courts costs (offered in kind by EA) £360.00. Total asked for: £360.00.'

JP queried upskilling teachers to make sustainable in future years. KJ. 'Part of the plan.'

2 Building Better Opportunities, South Hill Church, at Hemel Hempstead Leisure Centre, Dacorum. supported by EA – Kirsty Jones. In brief: '6 sessions, January start. Ages 18+ Those with learning difficulties, disabilities, or life challenges which have prevented individuals from being employed and having access to sporting opportunities. Equipment costs – Maude sport £144 senior badminton set including rackets, shuttles, two nets and a carry bag. Coach costs - £180 across 6 weeks. Courts costs £90 off peak (2 courts x 6 weeks.) Total asked for: £414.'

JP Keen to link in with Special Olympics not necessarily with this group.

Hertsmere Afghans Refugee sessions: Communities1st, Jeremy Stace: 'I have discussed a few opportunities with Helen. The offer for badminton is very much appreciated, but at the moment we are going to hold off putting on badminton for the refugees. The reasons for this are because we are working with a small budget that will not be able to facilitate a lot of the costs. We have also been advised by public health, that if we are putting on activities for the refugees, we need exclusivity of the venues we are using as they cannot mix with the public [DB: Owing to lack of vaccinations]. As you can imagine this is quite difficult especially with the costs.

If we need resources from your group for this project going forward, I will definitely be in touch.'
